Comments	The Women's heavy category is comprised of athletes weighing more than 63kg and less than or equal to 78kg; The Men's heavy category is comprised of athletes weighing more than 66kg and less than or equal to 81kg;					
Documentation	All athletes at the time of weigh-in must carry an identification document (D.N.I./Passport)					
Refereeing	Responsibility for Referee is the responsibility of the Associative Arbitration Commission, applying the rules in force adopted by the Portuguese Judo Federation.					
Competition System	If there are 9 or more teams registered, the competition will take place in a direct knockout system with a double repechage; If there are eight or fewer teams, pools will be made.					
Equipment	It is mandatory to use White and Blue Judogi.					
Draw	The draws will be held on May 5th (See program)

## Observations about the II Open International Mixed Team:

- The formation of the team must be submitted within the period indicated for the weigh-ins of the **II Open International Mixed Team AJDS**;
- Minimum number of athletes per team: 4 athletes (both genders must be represented);
- Maximum number of athletes per team: 12 athletes (Two athletes per weight category, female and male);
- Changes in weight categories are not permitted. Athletes can only compete in the weight category corresponding to their body weight. (e.g. A male cadet athlete who has a body weight of 55 kg will not be able to participate in the -66 kg category. With the exception of weight categories that are within a range);
- Before each match, the Team's responsible coach will have to submit the Team's constitution for that match duly completed. A Team loses due to failure to appear if it does not submit its constitution after three calls



spaced one minute apart. Meeting Sheets will be provided on the day of the test;

- In Team events, if a team does not have an athlete in a category, they must indicate the option “without competitor”. The team will always have to present an athlete, in the categories it has. An athlete cannot rest one match and return the next, unless he is replaced by a colleague in the same category.;
- In case of a tie in the match between two teams (in number of victories), a fight will be repeated. A weight category will be drawn (which has representatives on both teams). This fight will be carried out on a “golden point” basis.;

In Team events:

a) An athlete who presents himself in the initial salute and who does not actually compete in his match will not be able to participate in any match again during the event;

b) An athlete who refuses to fight or purposely loses the fight not only cannot fight anymore, but his team is penalized with a 6-0 defeat in that match.;

- In competitions played in a poule system, the following tiebreaker criteria apply successively:

a) Greater number of matches won;

b) Lower number of defeats in matches;

c) Greater number of victories (fights);

d) Greater number of points;

e) Result between tied teams.

- If, after applying the criteria set out in the previous number, there is still a tie, one of the weight categories will be drawn and a new fight will take place (“Golden Point Fight”);





- The draw provided for in the previous number includes all weight categories, including those whose fights were won due to no show;
- Clubs that do not have all the weight categories are allowed to bring together other athletes from other clubs, as long as the name of the team/club has 51% of the total number of athletes assigned to that same team/club;
- District Associations are allowed to participate as a team, as long as there are only athletes, registered/revalidated, from clubs within that association table;

### **Conduct of Coaches and Delegates:**

1. The coach and the delegate to the test will be responsible for the conduct of the Judocas at the beginning, during and at the end of the competition, namely before and at the end of each match;
2. Avoid any gesture of disrespect towards the referees, organization and public;
3. There will be no block of finals, so it will not be necessary Suit and Tie.
4. It is forbidden for coaches to guide their athletes with inappropriate footwear (Slippers), Caps, Jeans, among others.
5. If an infraction is detected, the offender will be sanctioned with the prohibition of sitting in the coach chair.
